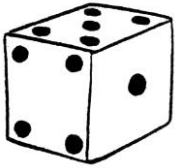


# Let's Talk

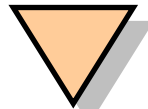
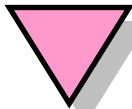

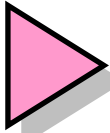

Do you prefer living in a small town or big city?

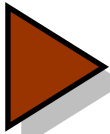
Would you like to live next to an airport? Why (not)?

Ask any question!

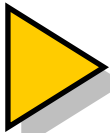

Describe the last time you used a bus or subway.

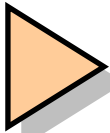
Compare your city with another city.
