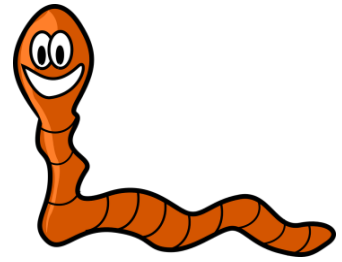

# Five Good Reasons to Have a Pet Worm



When you think about **pets**<sup>1</sup>, do you think about cats, dogs, birds and fish? Yes? Then you are like most people. But when I think about pets, I think about **worms**<sup>2</sup>. Yes, that's right, worms! Here, then, are five good **reasons**<sup>3</sup> to have a pet worm.

First, it costs a lot of money to buy some pets. However, you can find your own worm outside for free. Second, it costs a lot of money to buy food for some pets. For example, it can cost \$650 a year for dog food. But worms can eat old newspapers and **garbage**<sup>4</sup> from your kitchen. Third, when most pets are sick you have to bring them to an animal doctor and buy **medicine**<sup>5</sup> for them. But when your worm has an **accident**<sup>6</sup> and loses a **tail**<sup>7</sup>, don't worry. It can grow a new tail. Worms are also very quiet. Your neighbors will be very angry when your cat or dog makes a lot of noise. But they will never know that you have a pet worm! Finally, worms are safe. Cats and dogs can **bite**<sup>8</sup> you. However, worms never bite people, even when they are angry.

These are just five reasons to have a pet worm. There are many other great reasons to have a pet worm. What other reasons can you think of to have a pet worm?

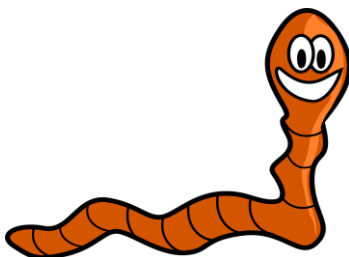
