night."

For example: "I don't
want to **oversleep** and
be late for work."

For example: "I like to
sleep in on Saturday
mornings."

For example: "I always
feel **sleepy** in the
afternoons."

For example: "I like to
wake up early on
school days."

sometimes **yawn** when
I'm tired."
